The Subsidies for Energy Efficiency in Kosovo (SEEK) is an MCC-supported project, implemented by MFK with the GFA/HPC Consortium as Implementing Consultant (IC). SEEK aims to reduce electricity consumption in the residential sector by piloting subsidies and other incentives to households to invest in energy efficiency measures.

The SEEK project consists of three (3) main intervention packages (IP):

- 1 Household Efficiency Retrofits (HER)
- 2 Apartment Building Efficiency Retrofits (AER), and
- 3 Women Energy Entrepreneur (WEE)

The main objective of the Apartment Building Energy Retrofits (AER) Intervention Package is to reduce the energy/electricity demand and related costs in the residential sector; increase the awareness on EE in the residential sector; enhance the competitiveness of the Kosovan energy service market, and support the EE benchmarks and incentive programs for further development in multi-family apartment buildings (MAB). The AER IP will provide grants to implement energy efficiency measures (EEM) in up to 25 multi-apartment buildings (MABs). Seven Municipalities participating in the AER IP will also contribute with grants to support apartment owners.
