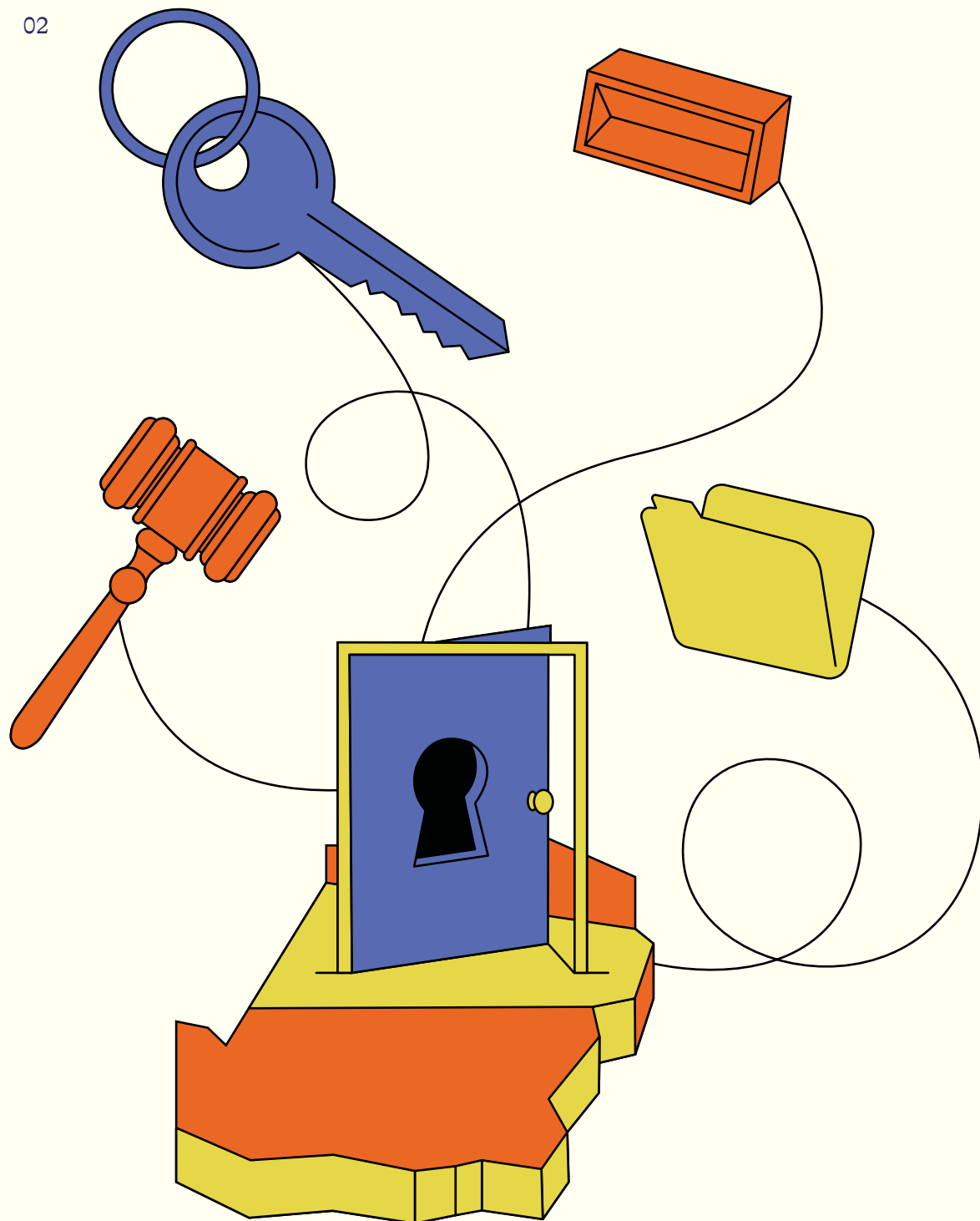


Public Access To Judicial Information (PAJI)



Public Access to Judicial Information Activity (PAJI)

The Public Access to Judicial Information (PAJI) contributes to the improvement Kosovo's justice administration. PAJI also helps increase transparency of the rule of law institutions by providing the citizens of Kosovo with online access to relevant judicial information. The public access is two-fold:

- Persons holding a case within the Kosovo judiciary (with authorized log-in): The Case Tracking Mechanism (in short, the "CTM") provides individual case information, case status and case updates, as well as procedural actions related to that case.
- PAJI also contributes to the improved communication and outreach by the judiciary and other rule of law institutions essential in maintaining a constructive dialogue with Civil Society organizations, media representatives, advocacy groups, and Kosovo citizens in general.

Individual Case Tracking Mechanism (CTM)

Kosovo's citizens can now gain online access to their individual judicial case.

To review case information, one must gain an authorized log-in (only available to people with a judicial case in Kosovo) and visit the KJC website (<https://ctm.gjyqesori-rks.org>). From there, the CTM platform allows access to individual case information through a vetted authentication procedure including:

- Personal ID for citizens;
- Business registration number;
- Lawyer license number;
- Name and Place.

Once logged in, the one can subscribe alerts related to one's case and receive updates by emails.

Open Data Platform (ODP)

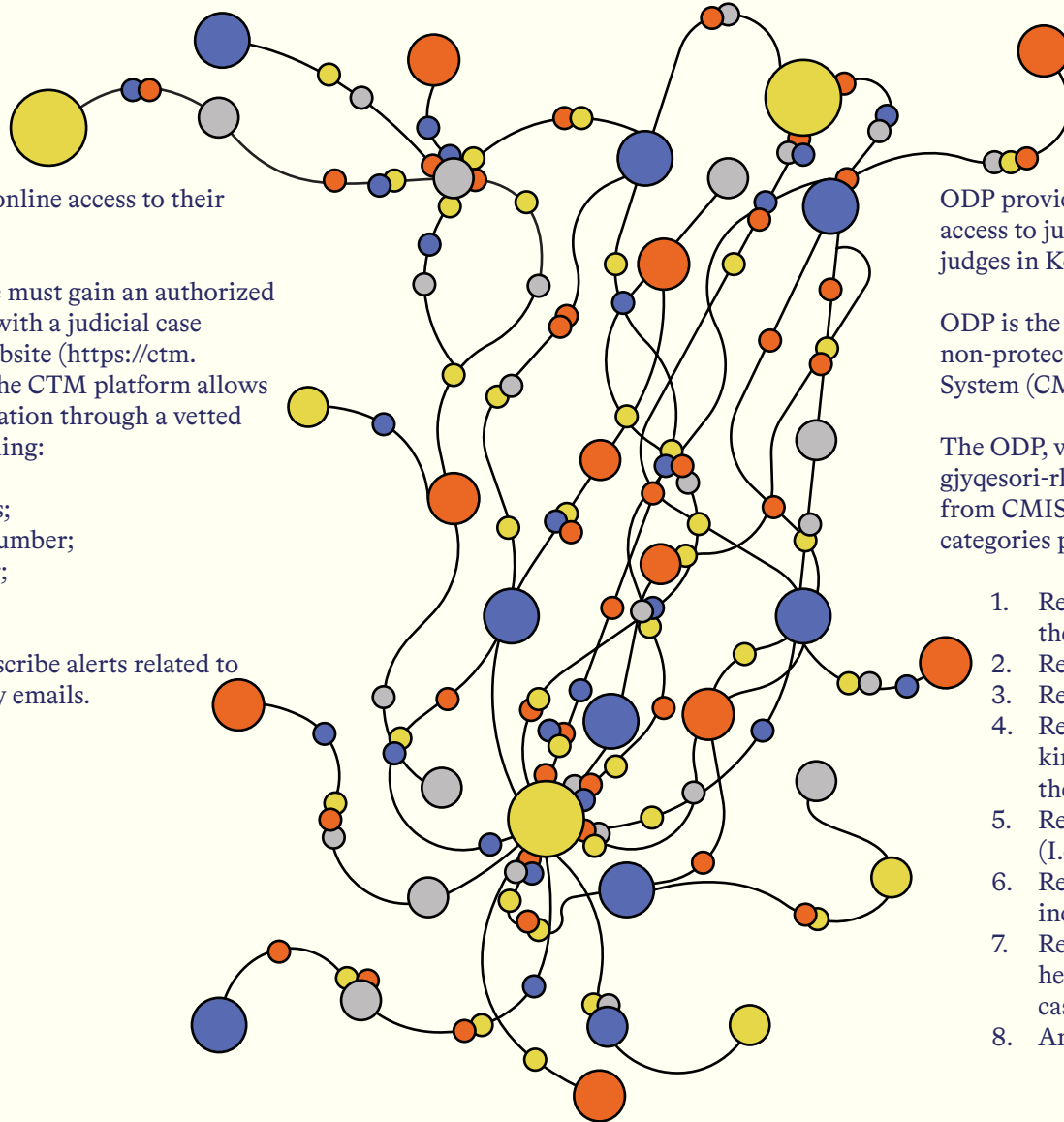

ODP provides the general public, and every internet user, with access to judicial statistics related to the work of courts and judges in Kosovo.

ODP is the mechanism to retrieve and analyze non-personal and non-protected data from Kosovo's Case Management Information System (CMIS).

The ODP, which also is hosted on the KJC website (<https://odp.gjyqesori-rks.org>) collects all non-personal metadata categories from CMIS and makes them available to the public. These data categories provide public users with following reports:

1. Report on the number of citizen requests submitted, and the number answered/addressed;
2. Report on the number of incoming and resolved cases;
3. Report on the number of cases resolved by each judge;
4. Report on how long it takes to resolve a specific kind of case from the moment the case is filed until the final verdict;
5. Report on the number of certain cases (I.e discrimination, hate crime, domestic violence);
6. Regular statistical reports of each court and individual judge;
7. Report on daily schedule (number) of session hearings for each courtroom (i.e., session type, case type, number of parties involved, etc.).
8. Any other relevant reports as they become necessary.

- ICT auditing;
- ICT security
- log analyses,
- ICT policies and standard operating procedures (SOP) for the use of the ICT infrastructure.

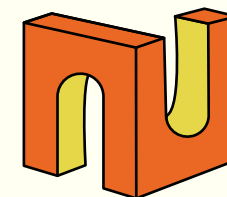
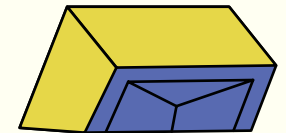
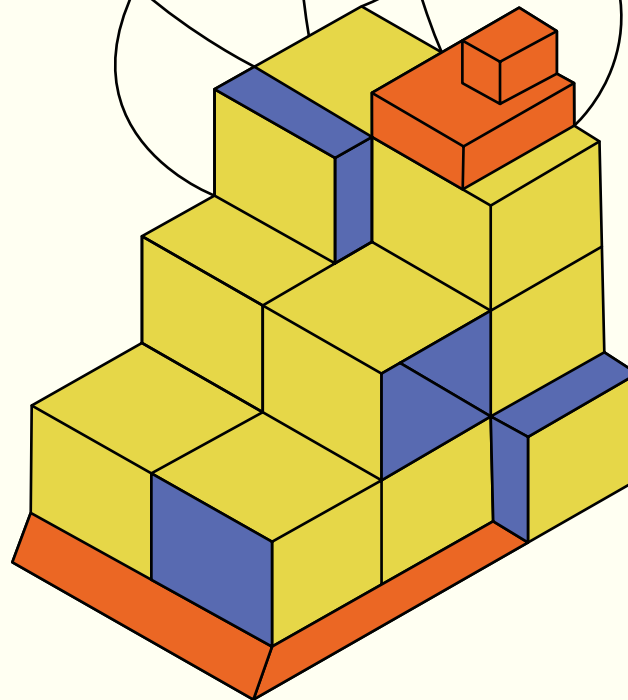
E-learning platform

Through PAJI, an E-learning platform has been created which ensures sustainability of training and the dissemination of relevant materials on a continuous basis, with the view of informing and educating the public and other interested stakeholders on ODP/CTM related issues.

All training modules are uploaded onto the e-learning platform and are available to the users. The e-learning platform opens new possibilities of training in the justice field for national trainers/lecturers, as well for other stakeholders with interest in the ODP and CTM systems.

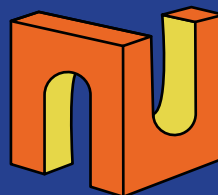
The ODP and CTM platforms are the sole responsibility and liability of KJC. Although developed with MCC funding, ODP and CTM are the full property of KJC and as such KJC is responsible and accountable for the accuracy and the completeness of the information provided through these platforms.



Both platforms obtain their data from KJC's Case Management Information System (CMIS), which is also the sole responsibility and liability of KJC. As such, the users of ODP and CTM must acknowledge that KJC is entirely responsible for any issues or concerns in connection with data and case information obtained.

KJC cautions that the ODP and CTM platforms for cases older than 2019 may contain outdated, inaccurate, or incomplete information for statistical purposes and may not present the real situation with the statistical data of the courts for the years before 2019. This is because the CMIS is a new system which has been deployed for the first time in the courts in 2018, that's why the data of the cases of 2018 and early years, meaning those older than the year 2018, may not contain all necessary detailed information regarding the actions undertaken by courts, caused by case management backlogs and/or errors in information technology. KJC is therefore the main and only point of contact for any problems arising from the functionality as well as from the retrieved judicial data and case information.
